ATA school is established by TAFSUS, a non-profit organization established in 1966 to promote better understanding and friendship between the Turkish and American communities through educational, cultural and social activities. In addition to TAFSUS, Turkish Cultural Foundation and the University of Pennsylvania Middle East Center are major financial contributors to ATA school.



Classes are offered to children starting age 4. Learning takes place in a fun, yet structured environment where students are encouraged to work on creative projects and to socialize with each other, further developing their language skills.

Program includes:
